Welcome pack for COP 22

All conference participants are invited to retrieve their welcome pack at the UN Information Desk Counter in Area I.

The welcome pack will be distributed daily on a first-come first served basis. With the reusable water bottle offered, participants can freely drink from all water fountains on the conference venue.

COP 22 electric vehicle shuttle services

There are two kinds of electrical vehicle available for transfers between the conference site and the 12 hotel zones:

- *Renault COP shuttle service*: Participants can request this service at the shuttle service "Help desk" in each designated hotel or at the Conference venue shuttle service hub.
- Toyota UberGreen shuttle service: Participants can download the Uber app available in <u>Google</u> and <u>iTunes</u> stores. Use the code "COP22" to request these electric cars for free hotel transfers. Further information is available at the entry/exit of the Blue Zone.

"Touch-to-collect" technology (Poken)

In line with the sustainability efforts for COP 22/CMP 12/CMA 1, innovative "touch-to-collect" technology (Poken) is deployed by the host country. Poken is a platform for collecting digital information and networking in a user-friendly way.

Participants can receive a personal Poken device, at no charge, at the Poken distribution counters located inside the side events and exhibits hall (Area E) and in the Moroccan Pavilion (Area D). Poken, once registered with personal login information, allows collecting digital information from the official exhibits, the side events and the Moroccan Pavilion, as well as recent secretariat's publications and daily reports by observer organizations.

The registration of personal login information also allows an exchange of digital business cards among participants holding a personal Poken device. Once collected information is loaded on participants' computer and the conference is over, Poken devices are no longer needed. Participants are invited to contribute to sustainability by recycling their Poken device on the last day.
