
Work programme under the framework for non-market approaches referred to in Article 6, paragraph 8, of the Paris Agreement

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA), pursuant to decision 1/CP.21, paragraphs 39 and 40, initiated the process related to the work programme under the framework for non-market approaches to sustainable development referred to in Article 6, paragraph 9, of the Paris Agreement.
- 2. The SBSTA noted that Parties engaged in a productive initial exchange of views on Article 6, paragraphs 8 and 9, of the Paris Agreement and decision 1.CP.21, paragraphs 39 and 40, throughout this session and agreed to focus on establishing common understanding at SBSTA 45 (November 2016) of the matters related to the work programme referred to in decision 1/CP.21, paragraphs 39 and 40.
- 3. The SBSTA invited Parties and observer organizations to submit by 30 September 2016 their views on the work programme referred to in paragraph 1 above.¹
