Presentation of the six (06) Regional Collaboration Centers

The secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change in partnership with six leading partners (BOAD/UNEP/EADB/IGES/WGEO/WINDREF are catalyzing climate action on the ground through the Regional Collaboration Centers by combining expertise in climate change and mastery of sub-regional realities with the aim of:

- Identify and evaluate projects with high climate potential;
- Provide technical support in the development, review and evaluation of various national plans and programs (NDC, LT-LEDS, NAPs etc);
- Ensure capacity building in the public and private sectors;
- Promote climate financing by identifying potential investors as well as their selection criteria and by supporting project leaders in the preparation of financing and investment proposals for their projects.


- Création : January 2013

Missions

The RCC West and Central Africa expanded its mandate after the Paris Agreement to:

- Facilitate the financing framework to mobilize climate finance in the coverage area
- Promote cooperation, information sharing of good climate practices
- Assist countries in their NDC-related activities
- Encourage stakeholders to collaborate and work on climate finance activities



Promoting tools (SBL and methodologies) that support environmental integrity and high-quality carbon credit.

Transition to Art 6.4 | Supporting a smooth transition to Art 6.4 Mechanism by assisting countries to meet participation requirement
