

Proposed Institutional Structure.....contd.

- Advisory Committee can act as an overarching body to provide guidance to SNLD's coordination body, the secretariat, and the national contact points to implement the functions of SNLD
- Secretariat will report to the Advisory Committee (AC) periodically and the AC will report back to COP and CMA through the SBs
- AC will recommend SNLD secretariat to provide TA and CB support to vulnerable developing countries
- The EC will provide policy guidance to the secretariat through the AC
- The L&D contact point shall execute all the actions including conducting needs assessment for TA at national and local level

Proposed Advisory Committee

- 5 Members from Annex I Parties
- 5 Members from Non-Annex I Parties
- 1 Member from SIDS
- 1 Member from LDCs
- 1 Member from EC of WIM
- 1 Member from SCF

- Need to establish a financial mechanism (as COP26/CMA3 agreed) to facilitate work of the SNLD
- The secretariat can be assigned to scrutinize the TA proposal from Parties and after endorsement by the AC, the proposal may be forwarded to the funding windows of UNFCCC
