Key principles for the AEF



Enable Parties to report on all elements in paragraph 20 of decision 2/CMA.3

The AEF should be able to reflect <u>different type of cooperative approaches</u> and not <u>limit</u> the way how Parties may engage in cooperative approaches

- Use towards NDCs
 ⇔ Use towards OIMP
- Baseline-credit approaches
 ⇔ ETS linking
- Underlying registries ⇔ No underlying registry
- Different types of voluntary support to Adaptation Fund

Key elements should be reflected in decision text

Action types and sub-types / first transfer

AEF reflects information recorded in ITMO registries and should be automatically prefilled by ITMO registries

Link to other negotiation items (e.g. first transfer, authorization, registries)

Relationship between Tables 2 and 3



EU's understanding of the relationship between Tables 2 and 3:

- Table 2: Authorization of the cooperative approach
- Table 3:
 - Authorization of specific ITMOs, OR (if permitted)
 - Identification of the ITMOs that are authorized based on a single authorization process

Underlying question: What is the "birth" of an ITMO?

Example: Use of carbon credits under CORSIA



Authorization of cooperative approach (or single authorization if permitted) in a document attached to IR

Table 2 of AEF:

Authorization for CORSIA only

Definition of "cancellation and use" as first transfer (...)

Underlying cooperative approach registry (e.g., VCS)

ITMO registry of the Party


