## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) considered the documents prepared for the session<sup>2</sup> and noted that the outcomes of the workshop to identify challenges and gaps in the implementation of risk management approaches to the adverse effects of climate change, which took place in Lima, Peru, from 10 to 12 October 2011, provide useful inputs into the implementation of the work programme on loss and damage.<sup>3</sup>

2. The SBI decided to recommend a draft decision on the work programme on loss and damage for adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its seventeenth session (for the text of the decision, see FCCC/SBI/2011/L.35/Add.1).
