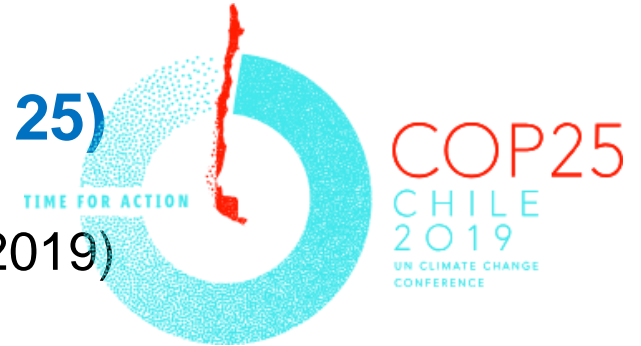

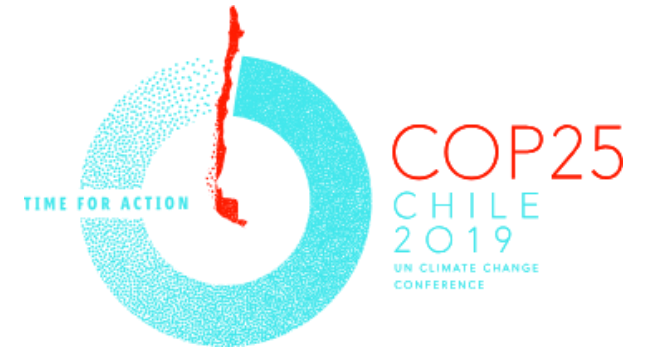
1. Milestones on the road to Santiago de Chile (COP 25)

- Take place on 2 – 13 December in Santiago de Chile
- Pre-sessional preparatory meetings will take place on 25 – 30 November

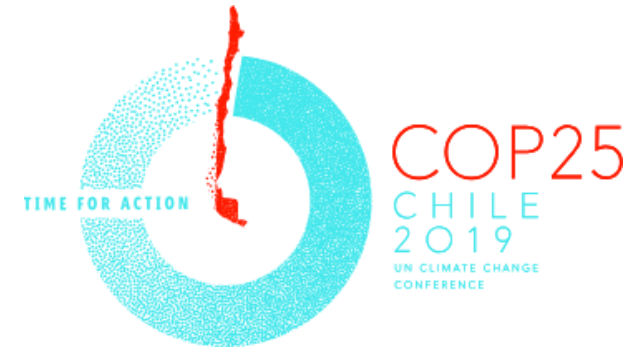
