The TEC has to date engaged its members in implementing its workplan activities through task forces. Options for TEC member engagement:

- For activity/deliverable that are confirmed for 2023-2024
 - Two TEC members to lead the activity, supported by secretariat
 - Engagement of partner organizations and observers are strongly encouraged
 - Report on progress of work at TEC meetings
 - Duration – until completion of activity
 - **AT TEC 26 invite** TEC members to volunteer
- For initial engagement with potential partners
 - TEC Chair and Vice-Chair to solicit engagements with potential partner organizations, supported by secretariat
 - Once idea is confirmed into tangible action, TEC Chair and Vice Chair will report to TEC, for further action

Partner organizations: On some activities where there are already organizations willing to take the lead.

- How does the TEC want to engage with them?
- One or two members could be the TEC liaison with the specific organization on that activity?
- Would feedback during TEC meetings, and emails inter-sessionally be sufficient?

Engagement of observers and Non-Party Stakeholders:

- Will representatives of observer organizations and NPS be invited to engage in TEC activity?
- How will observers and NPS be engaged in the activities led by partner organizations?

Engagement with other Constituted Bodies and other Expert Groups

- For activities supporting collaboration with constituted bodies, does TEC wish to have similar arrangement as other activities (e.g. 2 leads, engagement of observers, etc.)
- Does TEC need to appoint focal point for other constituted bodies not included in

WS4?
