



# 3. GCF Support for Climate Technologies



### Latest COP Guidance to the GCF

"Also encourages the Board to continue work on the request for proposals to establish **technology incubators and accelerators** in developing countries"

**COP27** decision

"Encourages further collaboration and engagement between the Green Climate Fund, the Climate Technology Centre and Network and the Technology Executive Committee, through **continued joint work, as well as collaboration on events**, and taking into consideration elements related to gender mainstreaming and observer engagement"

**COP26** decision

"Also encourages the Green Climate Fund to continue to collaborate with the Climate Technology Centre and Network and the Technology Executive Committee with **a view to both strengthening cooperative action on technology development and transfer** at different stages of the technology cycle and achieving a balance between support for mitigation and support for adaptation"

COP25 decision

"The Board shall also ensure adequate resources for capacity-building and **technology development and transfer**. The Fund will also provide resources for innovative and replicable approaches"




### Readiness Support for technology

#### Initial assessment # of approved readiness support for technology





# 4. Recommendations



### Enhancing collaboration between GCF and TEC

### **Adaptation Technology**

- Identify adaptation technologies that can be financed by private sector, including through incubators and accelerators
- Identify regions for furthering technology transfer needs particularly through **Direct Access Entities** (DAEs)
- Identify ways to help translate TNAs and Action Plans into concrete projects in conjunction with existing GCF frameworks/tools
