Draft provisional agenda for TEC-CTCN joint session

CMA.3 invited the TEC and the CTCN to continue their work on technology and NDCs in 2022–2023, in particular by implementing relevant recommendations in the joint publication on this topic,¹ The recommendations from this work for the Technology Mechanism include work on technology roadmaps and regularly updating the joint publication.

COP26 invited both bodies to strengthen their collaboration and the provision of feedback between them with a view to coherence and synergy and effective implementation of the mandates of the Technology Mechanism, inter alia by exploring the preparation of a joint programme.²

In response to these invitations, the TEC and CTCN agreed on joint activities to be undertaken during the period of 2022-2023.³

This joint session aims to:

1. Share up-to-date information from both bodies' activities, including feedback from the work of each body;
2. Take stock of progress of and provide guidance for the implementation of existing joint activities;
3. Discuss the draft Technology Mechanism Work Programme.
