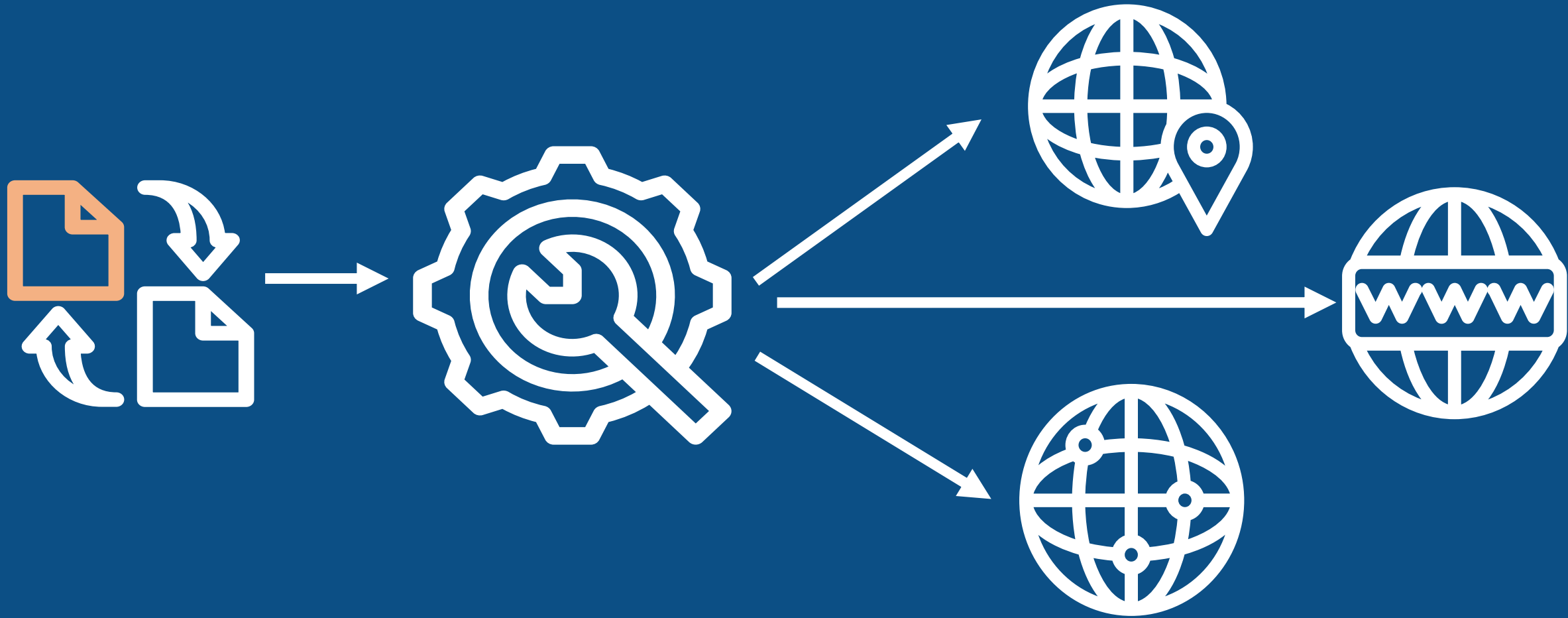

coordination mechanism:** established in 19 countries



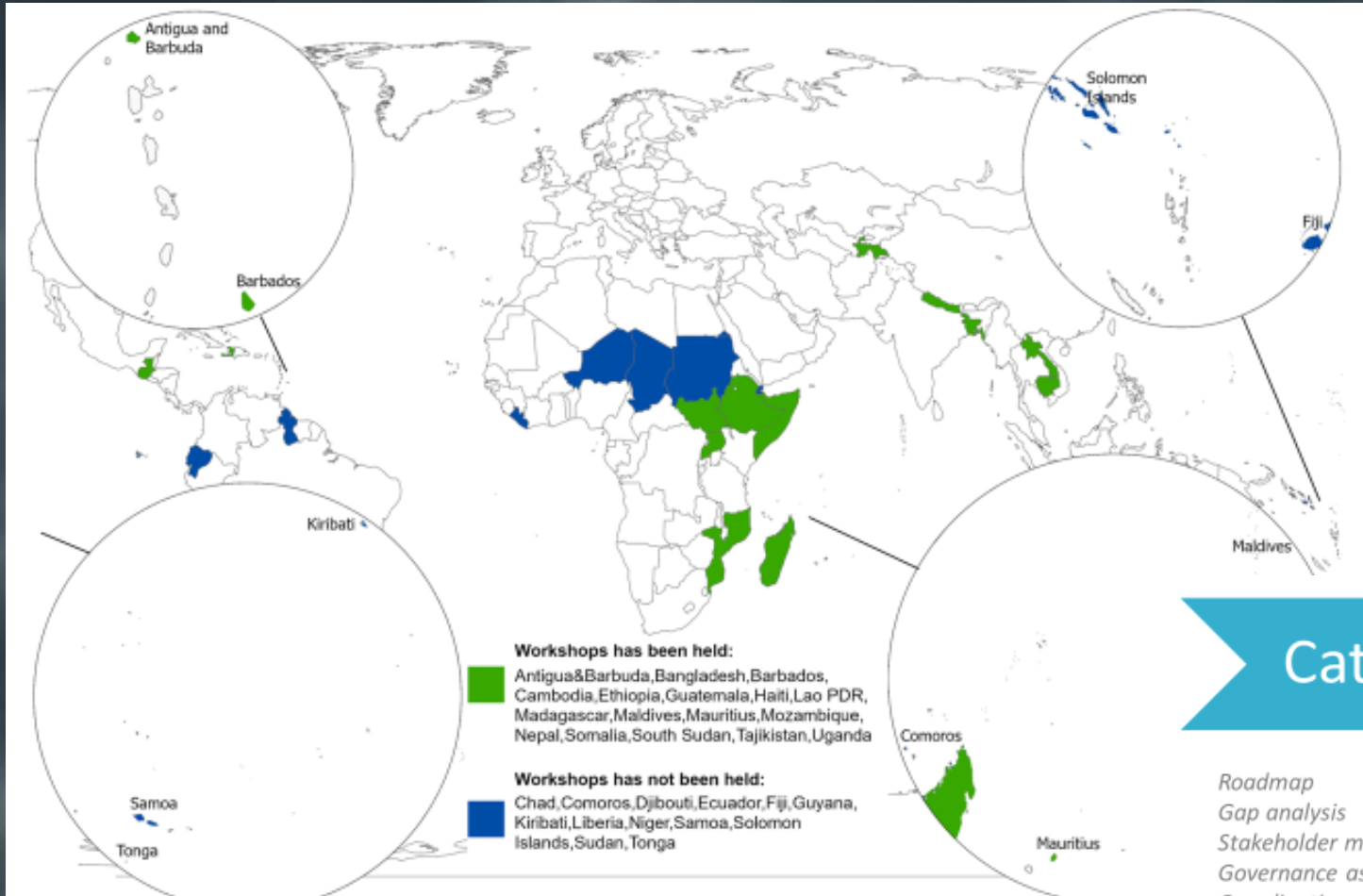

Interpillar Implementation Building Blocks

Core areas of technical collaboration to complement pillar specific activities & strengthen EWS in countries



IMPACT BASED FORECASTING

Implement advanced forecasting techniques focusing on impacts to enhance the accuracy, lead time and contextualisation of warnings. Provide technical training to NDMAs and Met Services on IBF; Support the set-up of situation rooms.



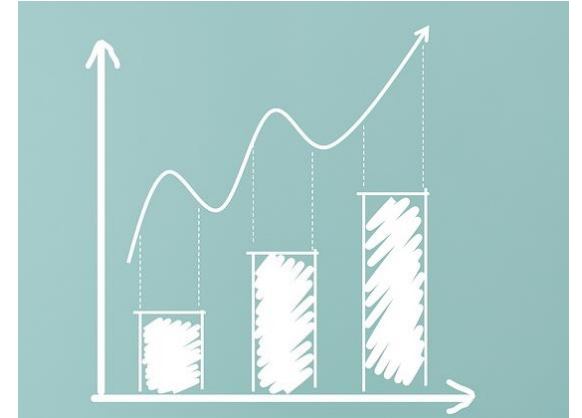
RISK & WARNING COMMUNICATION

Strengthen risk communication strategies and implement CAP for effective and standardized alerting; Facilitate CAP training and integration with existing alert systems; Support the development of multi-channel communication plans.



ANTICIPATORY ACTION

Establish targeted mechanisms to support anticipatory actions based on impact scenarios and early warnings; Trigger thresholds; Protocols for activating anticipatory actions; coordination frameworks among relevant agencies; regular drills.



EWS GOVERNANCE

Establish governance frameworks and policy **structures** for effective EWS; Provide policy guidance and templates; Collaborate with governments to develop EWS governance and coordination structures.
