Participation in COP and SBs	NDEs request the CTCN to organize coordination meetings with UNFCCC focal points, NDAs and NDEs	NDEs report difficulties in engaging with the NDAs of their countries as well as other financial mechanism's focal points because of a lack of legitimacy.
