## **BACKGROUND**

- TEC 24 provided guidance on the **preparation of a publication on gender and technology** and agreed to further discuss it in the context of the consideration of its new rolling workplan
- The TEC **gender focal points consulted intersessionally** with CTCN, UN Women, the Women and Gender Constituency, the UNFCCC Gender Team and other organizations on **possible topics** for the TEC publication



- The gender focal points concluded that the TEC work on **sustainable transport** offers the opportunity for an analysis of gender-responsive solutions that is **complementary to both the work of the TEC and the CTCN**, on a sector that is not covered by the current work of the consulted organizations:
  - Resources and time associated with the development of the TEC technical paper on sustainable road mobility did not allow an in-depth analysis of technologies and infrastructure that are gender-inclusive
  - CTCN technical assistance projects on sustainable transport may offer real case examples on gender-inclusive policy options for sustainable road mobility

## **POLICY BRIEF**

### **Objective and scope**

- To build on current work of the TEC and take into account outcomes from the CTCN technical assistance projects
- To provide an overview of sustainable transport technologies and infrastructure that are gender-inclusive and consider women travel behaviour
- To offer policy options that can effectively support the deployment of gender-inclusive technology and infrastructure for sustainable road mobility
