# **Mandate**

Decision 15/CMA.1, Annex, para 12 c – Reviewing the TNA guidelines and **updating** them

Decision 12/CP.21 Para 67

- (a) undertake, **update** & implement TNAs,TAPs
- (b) financial and technical support for the implementation of TNAs.

SBI/2022/L.10

TEC & CTCN:

how developing countries can be supported in **updating their TNAs** and implementing their TAP and TNA outcomes

TEC rolling workplan 2023-27:

- i. Gap assessment of guidance on TNA (2023)
- ii. Event with financial actors to raise awareness on TNA (SB58)



### Methodology

- Terminal Evaluations of TNA Phase I and II (UNEP Evaluation Office 2016 and 2020)
- TNA Synthesis report (success stories, lessons learned and challenges)
- Feedback from the Global TNA Project participating countries (on TNA methodology, guidebooks, country support, capacity building)
- Inputs from the operating entities of the UNFCCC Financial Mechanism GEF, GCF (to attract further financial resources for implementation)
- Inputs form the Global TNA Project Implementing and Executing agencies, UNEP and UNEP-CCC (experience with developing methodology and guidebooks, capacity building and country support)
- Review of existing TNA implementation efforts (building upon 50 implemented TNAs/TAPs)
- Consultation with the CTCN (CTCN supports countries to develop their TNA and TAP through GCF Readiness, and is mandated to support countries implement TNA results)
- Guidance from the TEC (including TEC work that has investigated TNA/TAP implementation efforts)



# **Current TNA guidance and process**




- Sector selection (pre and post PA era)

# **Evolution of TNA guidance**

Main step-by-step guidebook not updated on emerging issues such as transformational change, gender, ownership & engagement across departments, stakeholders, and financial actors, though individual guidance material exists.

More involvement of the **private sector** in the TNA steps could be emphasised through targeted practical guidance.

The role of TNAs and TAPs in preparing and implementing **long-term strategies**, and other emerging issues, should be included.

Up-to-date guidance on mitigation in the **energy sector** is not available.

Guidance on **monitoring and evaluation** is embodied in the TAP guidance but beyond the scope of the supported TNA projects, requiring in-kind resources or additional support, as well as updating.



#### Recommendations

The TEC may consider the recommendations and provide further guidance to reflect in the follow-up activity scheduled for 2025-

**Update guidance** based on finding of **gap assessment** (2023).

Update the TNA main guidebook in collaboration with UNEP-CCC to reflect matters related to transformational change, challenges and experiences in TNA III & IV etc.

Prepare a **new guidebook** on the role of TNAs and TAPs in preparing and implementing **long-term strategies**.

Prepare a **new practical guidebook** for facilitating the involvement of **private sector** at all stages of TNA (in particular TAPs and project ideas)

Prepare a sectoral guidebook on mitigation technologies for the energy sector.

Guidance for **updating TNAs and TAPs** following the NDC update cycle, tool for **monitoring and evaluation** of the TNAs and TAPs.
