

Ninth meeting of the Technology Executive Committee Bonn, Germany, 18–21 August 2014

Information for participants

This document answers commonly asked questions and provides a range of information to facilitate your participation and stay during the meeting.

Where is the meeting venue?

The 9th meeting of the Technology Executive Committee (TEC) will be held at the building “Langer Eugen” on the United Nations Campus in Bonn, in Room 1916 (19th floor), located at

Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1, D-53113, Bonn. A map with the location of the UN campus can be found in the Annex below.

When is the meeting?

The 9th meeting of the TEC from 18 August, beginning at 1:30 p.m., to 21 August 2014.

Where do I get my conference badge?

TEC members, Parties and observers can register at the Registration Counter located at the entrance of Langer Eugen.

Badges are issued to participants on the basis of receipt of a registration form. Representatives of Observer Organizations must be registered in order to be issued a badge.

12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m.

There is little space for car parking at the UN Campus. However, cars can be parked in one of the parking areas you pass along Charles-de-Gaulle-Str. Located on the back of the campus at the river side, there is a big parking space. The costs for whole day parking will be 5 Euro.

By air:

From Cologne/Bonn airport (Flughafen Koeln/Bonn):

Airport-shuttle-bus No SB60 towards Bonn

Bus line "SB60" (airport express) services the 25 kilometer stretch between Cologne/Bonn Airport and the Bonn Main Railway Station. The journey is foreseen to take approx. 30 min. At the time of writing, one-way tickets are sold at EUR 6.90.

In weekdays, the bus leaves every 30 min. while it leaves every 30/60 min. on Saturdays and Sundays. For exact timetables, please refer to the SWB Web site [here](#).

Hauptbahnhof (main railway station)

Underground (U-Bahn) line 16, 63 or 66 towards Bad Godesberg/Koenigswinter

From Frankfurt airpoirt (Flughafen Frankfurt)

There is a fast train (Intercity train) from Frankfurt airport to Siegburg/Bonn. From Siegburg you can take a taxi (555 555) to the UN Campus. By taxi

The fare for a taxi ride to Langer Eugen (Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1) from Bonn city centre and Hauptbahnhof is around 8 Euro. The central phone number for Bonn taxis is 555 555.

DSA disbursement and travel

We warmly encourage you to receive your daily subsistence allowance (DSA) payment by bank transfer to reduce logistical preparation and time spent during the meeting to receive DSA on-site. If DSA payment by bank transfer is not an option, TEC members eligible for funding can collect their DSA at the secretariat office located next to the meeting room 1916. You will need your passport or other official identification (with photo ID), flight ticket and boarding pass stubs when claiming DSA. Exact timing for the DSA disbursement will be made available in due time.

Participants' Centre

The Participants' Centre is located in the area close to meeting room 1916. Computers and a printer are available for participants. These computers provide Internet access and are equipped with word processing and spreadsheet software.
