Cooperation with the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change

The Conference of the Parties,

Noting the conclusions of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice at its eleventh session (FCCC/SBSTA/1999/L.15),

1. *Expresses its appreciation* to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, particularly its authors and scientists, for the high quality of its work;
2. *Notes with concern* the urgent appeal for additional resources by the Chairman of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change;
3. *Urges* Parties, intergovernmental organizations, [including the Global Environment Facility,] and other organizations in a position to do so, to contribute financial support early and generously to the work of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, to enable it to complete its third assessment report and special reports, in view of their importance to advancing the Convention process.
