

## **DESCRIPTION**



Globally, about 70% of the developing country NDCs and 83% of the LDC NDCs submitted to the UNFCCC put capacity building as a condition to implement their NDCs.

This need for capacity building support overwhelms other kinds of international assistance including for climate finance.

Capacity building as a non-politicized agenda under the politically charged UNFCCC process is coming up as a very important issue.

The purpose of the webinar was to have a frank dialogue with the LDC partners to explore the broad capacity needs and gaps to address climate change more effectively.

The event followed a brief presentation on capacity building, followed with a panel discussion where designated discussants focused on the importance of the long-term capacity building needs for different stakeholders in the LDCs as well as how this can be achieved.
