The National Adaptation Plans (NAPs) is a key mechanism for defining adaptation priorities, channeling resources, and implementing adaptation actions.

This toolkit is designed to support country efforts to pursue a genderresponsive NAP formulation process, including in the establishment of institutional arrangements, capacity development, stakeholder engagement, information sharing, and securing finance.

The toolkit is organized around the key entry points in the NAP process, based on the elements outlined in the UNFCCC Technical Guidelines for the NAP Process produced by the Least Developed Countries Expert Group (LEG)
