DESCRIPTION

Acting at the interface between natural resources and human activities, forests, trees and agroforestry provide numerous nature-based solutions to adaptation.

Forests need to adapt and become more resilient so they can continue to deliver crucial ecosystem services, including those on which other agriculture sectors depend - including crops, livestock, and fisheries.

This publication is designed to help countries integrate these considerations into adaptation planning through the National Adaptation Plan (NAP) process.
