The United Nations Industrial Development Organization is carrying out programmes to help countries to accelerate the shift to more sustainable transport systems in order to meet the sustainable development goals.

In response to growing member interest to expand and further develop electric vehicles (EVs) programmes, UNIDO convened an Expert Panel Meeting, “Smart Mobility for Smart Cities”, to examine market trends, share best practices and lessons learned, and to assess the challenges ahead.
