

Hungary and the Rio Conventions (2)

- UNFCCC: Hungary ratified in 1994 Kyoto Protocol: Hungary acceded in 2002
- UNCCD: Hungary acceded in 1999
- CBD: Hungary ratified in 1994 Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety: Hungary's ratification in progress
- United Nations Forest Forum: active participation

Dimensions of the synergy approach (2)

Environmental aspects

- forest-related interlinkages: vegetation cover (desertification), sinks for carbon (climate system), forest biodiversity...
- climate change: impacts on ecosystems, biodiversity, their vulnerability and adaptation; impacts on desertification processes...

Reinforcing the synergies of the Rio Conventions

Dimensions of the synergy approach (3)

Policy-relevant aspects (response policies)

- increase forest cover: sustainable forest management; enhanced sink capacities; halt desertification
- combat desertification/drought: links with the climate change mitigation/adaptation measures
- policies and measures are needed that take account also of the impacts on the other subject matters

Dimensions of the synergy approach (4)

Institutional co-operation

- systematic observation, data systems on the state of the environment
- co-ordination between institutions at all levels
- integrated assessment of proposed response policies
- reporting requirements (national level, IGOs ..)

Dimensions of the synergy approach (5)

Financial aspects

- comprehensive approach needed to effectively use limited financial resources (overall cost-benefit assessment)

Public participation

- Rio Declaration (principle 10)
- stakeholder involvement: access to info, publ. part.

- UNFCCC, KP: commitment
- UNCCD: affected country
- CBD: rich biodiversity
- forest management

Hungary and the synergy approach (2)

Policy aspects of implementation

- UNFCCC, KP: Second National Environmental Programme - Sub-programme on climate change; sector-related programmes; inventories and NC-s
- UNCCD: National Drought Strategy in the process of consultations, NR
- CBD: National Biodiversity Strategy under elaboration
- National Afforestation Programme: ongoing

Hungary and the synergy approach (3)

Institutional aspects of implementation

- National Co-ordinating Body: Ministry of Environment and Water for the three conventions
- National Focal Points: work in the same department of the Ministry of Environment and Water
- parallel structures and shared responsibility for drought and forest issues with the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development
