# Lessons learned

- The application of tools depends on the national circumstances and are dependent on the complexity or simplicity of the country as well as the needs urgent and immediate versus long term
- Models should be viewed as a data interphase among all stakeholders, policy makers, scientific community and research community in finding common strategies for addressing vulnerabilities
- The results of any sectoral assessments in V&A will only be policy-relevant if linked with socio-economic development issues.

### Lessons learned

Addressing the needs of participants of a regional training workshop involving participants from countries with varying ecosystems and development priorities is a major challenge

- Region/sub-region vs. vulnerability- or resource-based training
- Tool-based vs. process-based training
- There is a need to develop assessment tools for the health sector
- Ensuring the right participants to the workshop
