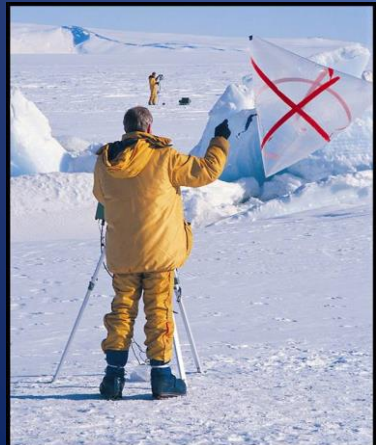
Systemic Observations need:

- Commitment to the long term
- Investment, human as well as financial
- Ongoing calibration and maintenance
- Satellite data expensive (heavy computing)



Ongoing Capacity Development:

- Language, translation into local languages
- Training
- Data recovery
- Digitisation



Pressure :

- To reduce costs therefore to reduce measuring sites.
