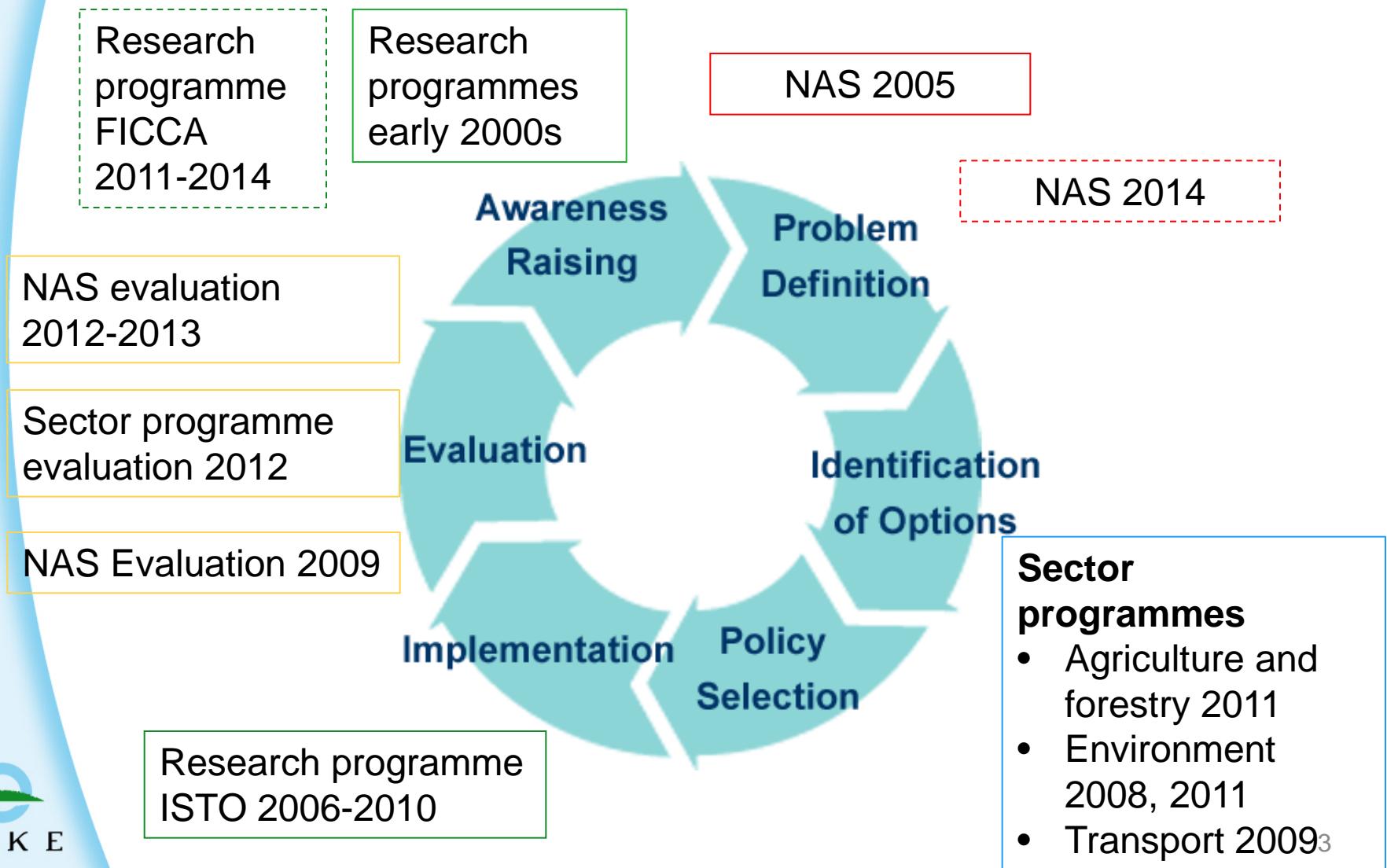

Adaptation policy cycle

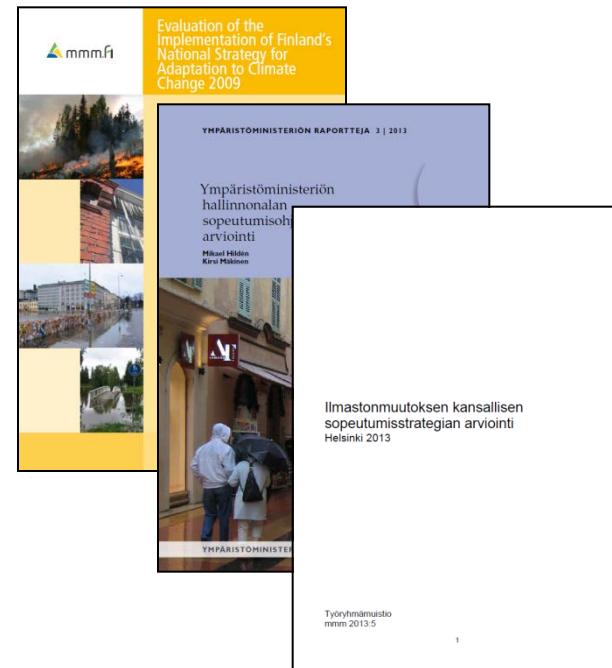

Ivalo flood risk map (1/1000a)

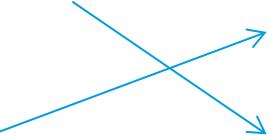
Barriers and some solutions

Lack of uptake by "all" sectors



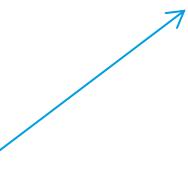
Evaluation - Self reflection among sectoral policy makers
