
# Background: Niche

- NWP has entered into the second phase, and another 1.5 years to complete
- Weak link with the Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA: 2005-2015)...Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) linkages
- Among the partners, there are very few Asian universities: lack of interest or lack of information?
- Higher education and research (with field applications) is rather less focused: need is felt, but few drivers..

#### **Target of AUEDM**
