Economic diversification

- **Technical workshop** on increasing economic resilience to climate change and reducing reliance on vulnerable economic sectors, including through economic diversification, Cairo, Egypt, 28-30 April 2009 [*an preliminary report*]

Organizations, institutions, experts and communities

- 11 additional organizations and institutions appointed a focal point since SBSTA29;
- 133 partner organization in total as of 1 May 2009

Private sector

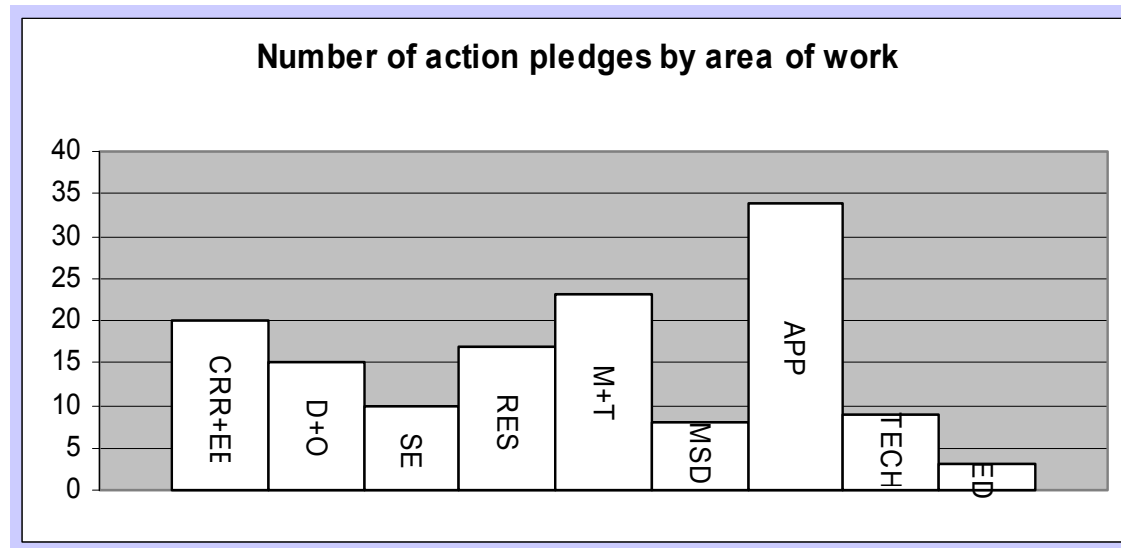
- The Private Sector Initiative;

- 21 new action pledges from 14 organizations;
- 82 pledges in total, from 32 organization;
