- Emerging national and regional adaptation networks












Role of NWP in national level activities

- Some benefit from "methods and tools" "climate modelling" "climate related risks and extreme events"
- Stakeholder engagement with scenario uncertainty still challenging
- Rather little benefit from "adaptation planning and practices"
- Low level of uptake and engagement especially from organizations relating to on-the-ground activities
- Sub-themes of NWP have not been "actionoriented" enough – not enough concrete guidance

Key points
