Subject: Submission on possible elements of a successor work programme on Article 6 of the Convention.

Georgia is pleased to present its views on the draft version of Doha work programme on Article 6 of the Convention, review of the amended New Delhi work programme and possible elements of a successor programme on Article 6 of the Convention.

We would like to add the following proposals in the Doha work programme on Article 6 of the convention:

D. Implementation

Parties

Item 23

(z) To prepare National Reports on the implementation of the Doha work programme for the purpose of reviewing the programme in 2016.

Role of the secretariat

Item 37

(c') To establish a forum for National Focal Points of Article 6 of convention (NFP Forum of Article 6), which will facilitate implementation of the Article 6 by Parties through enhancing the interaction with designated focal points. The NFP Forum of Article 6 of convention is to provide opportunities for Parties' representatives to exchange views share their experiences relating to the implementation of the work programme and bring forward common views and issues to the attention of the COP.

(h') To place more emphasis on training, capacity building and institutional strengthening; training should be tailored to relevant target groups of decision makers and specialists.

We look forward to the opportunity to further discuss the Doha work programme at COP 19 to be held in Doha, Qatar from 26 November to 7 December 2012.
