I: Background and context

- ❖ SBI 40 invited the AC in collaboration with the LEG to organize a workshop drawing upon experts and practitioners at different levels to **share experiences, good practices, lessons learned, gaps and needs on the process to formulate and implement NAPs** to be held prior to SBI 42 (June 2015).
- ❖ An information paper **FCCC/SBI/2014/INF.14**, prepared by the LEG and the AC for SBI 41 which will serve as input to this workshop and consideration of M&E by SBI
- ❖ COP 20 decided to explore options for **enhancing reporting** related to the process to formulate and implement NAPs as part of this workshop.
- ❖ The SBI invited the AC, in collaboration with the LEG to **prepare a report for consideration at SBI 42**, taking into account this workshop and other documents for consideration by COP.



II: Summary

- ❖ The workshop will take place from **16 to 17 April 2015 in Bonn**, Germany, immediately following the NAP Expo which will be held from 14 to 15 April 2015.
