
Coherence at national level

- Interministerial working group on CCA (2007-)
- Norwegian Adaptation Programme (2007-2013)
- Institutionalising the Norwegian Adaptation Programme (TBD 2013-)
- Authority for sea-level rise and surface runoff water (TBD)
- Thematic areas of work: DDR and climate change – addressing interdependencies (2010/11-)



Bridging national-sub-national and local level

- Creating arenas for peer-learning – "Cities of the future" (2008-2014)
- Regional support and learning platforms through the County Governors office
- Involvement of local planners in developing tools and methods
- National clearing house (2009-)



Towards a structured approach to integrate adaptation

- Developing a *soft-law on adaptation* for planning at local level
 - a) Facilitate coordination at national level
 - b) Speaking with one voice
 - c) Linking and integrating climate change in to existing regulations on water management, DRR, agriculture, roads, building codes etc.


