

ToRs ad hoc group on technical support (12 March 2014)

Objective	To propose modalities for providing support to Parties on adaptation, for consideration by the AC
Tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">– To analyze existing support for adaptation action provided by regional institutions and UN agencies, including gaps, needs and opportunities, based on the submissions by regional institutions and UN agencies and other relevant information, including related to issues such as geographic coverage, types and degree of technical assistance, and associated institutional and financial arrangements;– Taking into account the above gaps, needs and opportunities, propose modalities to strengthen and to enhance coherence of the provision of support to developing countries for activities related to adaptation
Size and composition	4 members of the AC, including a lead AC member (other members are welcome to join, if desired). Ad hoc group would invite experts and representatives from relevant organizations and constituted bodies to engage
Duration of the ad-hoc group	Until AC8, at which the AC will consider the proposed modalities and finalize and adopt them for subsequent implementation
Reporting	The group will report, through its AC members, at each AC meeting up till AC8, on progress made in undertaking its tasks.
Mode of work	The group will work mainly through electronic means of communication. Members of the ad-hoc group who are not members of the AC could be invited to AC meetings, as necessary and appropriate, and subject to the availability of resources.
