Section B

- Responding to COP18, a proposal is developed for a workstream on means of implementation, articulating to the COP that activities in its work plan are not stand-alone activities, but rather build upon one another
- The proposal, contained in table 1, seeks to build on existing activities in the workplan and their outputs and deliverables, follow up on their outputs, and identify new activities that may be necessary to enable work on this matter.
- Further, there is a proposal for a joint-task force on means of implementation to include representatives from the constituted bodies

- Additionally, there is a proposal for a Workstream on adaptation technical support and guidance to the Parties, also responding to COP18.
- This work related to technical support and guidance to the Parties is present in multiple activities and it seeks to establish a clear workstream on coherence related to adaptation action, technical support and guidance to the Parties (Table 2).
- Under this workstream, activities done in collaboration with other bodies under the Convention
