I: Background and context (1)

Addressed items on the AF in 2013

- Goal: raise the profile of adaptation globally
- Format: 3 hrs event;
 - Interventions/dialogue among known personalities from a balance of regions and areas of focus
 - Interventions from high country representatives and/or heads of international agencies, businesses and civil society
 - Both components may lead into a town-hall style of interaction with the audience
- Title: Towards a climate resilient future
- Scope: sharing practical experiences rather than specifics of the negotiations



I: Background and context (2)

Addressed items on the AF in 2013

- Other aspects:
 - Reach out to the broader public rather than those physically present
 - Speakers should enjoy international recognition and exceptional communication skills
 - Mayor Bloomberg would be a great speaker to talk about the NYC adaptation efforts
 - Balance of presenters (e.g. governments, private sector, regions) should be achieved
 - Sponsorship by a global television network would be great
 - COP Presidency should help secure the most viable venue
 - Timing: close to the HLS; no overlap with COP plenary

Information provided by the secretariat (Youssef)

- Personalities that could offer their vision for future climate resilience: Three Nobel Prize co-recipients; Major Bloomberg, Ms. Mary Robinson; contacts to Warner Brothers to secure a show business celebrity with interest in the topic; Global Compact to provide a high powered CEO
- Media partnership: Al Jazeera or as fallback GreenTV and use of UN channels for dissemination
- Venue: Warsaw Palace of Science and Culture or as fallback a negotiating room in the Conference Center
- Further support requested from the AC to identify/approach personalities representing the regions
