Priorities

- Key sectors: agriculture food security, water, tourism, energy ecosystems and DRR
- Loss and damage mainly from extreme events, but due to adaptation deficit
- Austria: importance to plan ahead to transform electricity system
- Increase resilience and reduce risk thus promote and implement adaptation
- Many CRM solutions help reduce multiple risks

Experiences

- Public and private insurance scheme: Chile and Uruguay; IADB
- Policies and guidelines: Colombia and Mexico
- Need to mainstream ACC and DRR into dev.
- Current development pattern creates risk – need to build resilience
- Problem of electoral cycles, need for policy consistency and budgets
- Important regional experiences provide lessons

Linkages and Synergies

- Chile: collaborating with Spain and FAO on agricultural insurance
- Japan: public private partnerships
- Colombia: coordination bodies; int. Cooperation
- Mexico: interministerial comission
- Need to strenghten linkages at both institutional and policy level

Toolkits

- Austria: inventory of hazards
- Panama: National DRR and CC policy linked to international funding scheme
- Uruguay: agricultural information system to build indexes, also uses Desinventar
- Data processing and access of key users remains huge challenge
- CC should be mainstreamed into other tools
- Link up to international databases
