## Food & Restaurants

Participants may opt to have their choice of lunch at the meeting venue or in the neighbourly surroundings in walking distance.

# **Registration:**

Participants are required to register and obtain identification badges prior to the opening of the meeting on Tuesday, 9 October 2012 from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m. For this purpose, a registration counter will be set up in front of the meeting room to be announced at the lobby of the Hilton Barbados Hotel.

## **Health requirements:**

We recommend that you consult the appropriate health authorities in your country well in advance in connection with possible vaccinations and health precautions for Barbados.

Yellow fever vaccination is required to those travellers who arrive within 6 days from endemic countries or transiting through infected areas. Participants may wish to consult their doctor on recommended precautions against malaria and/or yellow fever. The list of endemic countries is detailed below for easy reference:

Angola, Argentina, Benin, Bolivia, Brazil, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Colombia, Congo, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ivory Coast, Ecuador, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, French Guyana, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Guyana, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Panama, Peru, Paraguay, Rwanda, Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Suriname, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Republic of Tanzania, Venezuela.

# **Insurance:**

Participants are strongly advised to obtain international travel and medical insurance to cover the period of their departure for the expert meeting until the time of their return.

# **General information**

## Geography and climate:

Barbados is a limestone island which is 21 miles by 14 miles wide, making a total of 166 square miles. It is the easternmost island in the Caribbean chain, located northeast of Venezuela and west of Africa. The highest point on the island is Mount Hillaby on the east coast, which is 1,089 feet. Year-round climate is with average temperatures ranging between 24 and 29 degrees Celsius and a gentle sea breeze courtesy of the north east trade winds.

# **Official language:**

The official language in Barbados is English.

## Time zone:

Standard time zone: UTC/GMT -4 hours.



## Weather information:

Barbados weather is generally warm and sunny all year round with an average daytime high of 24 and 29°C. The nights are usually slightly cooler. The prevailing northeast trade winds blow steadily so that although it is bright and sunny, it is not unbearably hot. Rain usually comes in quick showers. The dry season lasts from January to June.

#### **Electricity:**



Most hotels provide adaptors for European or Asian appliances. North American appliances do not need adapters.

#### **Currency:**

The Barbados currency is the Barbados Dollar (BBD) Bank Notes: 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 and 100 BBD Coins: 1, 5, 10 and 25 Cents, and 1 BBD The exchange rate is bound to the US Dollar: 1 BBD = 2 US\$ (fix)

## **Credit Cards:**

Credit cards are widely accepted.

#### International country code:

Barbados: +1 246.

## Taxes & Charges:

Should you stay in a hotel or villa during your stay in Barbados, 7.5% VAT and a 10% service charge may be added to your bill.

Most hotels and restaurants add a 10-15% service charge to the bill.

#### **Departure tax:**

Upon leaving Barbados, all travellers are required to pay a Departure Tax of BBD \$60.00. This fee is paid at the Grantley Adams International Airport when checking-in. Some travel agents include this tax at the time of issuing your ticket. To check whether or not you have already been charged, refer to your ticket and look for a small voucher stating Departure Tax. The Check-in agent will keep a portion of this voucher for their records.

## **Tipping:**

Tipping is left to the discretion of the individual unless included in the bill; standard range is 10-15% of the overall bill.
