# Experiences shared

- Cross-ministerial coordination at national level required, as well as between national and local levels
- Climate change or adaptation committees at national level facilitate coordination efforts (e.g. Bangladesh)
- Local institutions responsible for implementation at community level
- Non-governmental actors may help in translating information for end users

# Priorities for further work

- Relevant data and appropriate communication to end users
- Awareness raising across ministries and in local institutions to be improved
- Political will essential to drive an integrated approach, e.g. Cook Islands
- Multi-stakeholder participation
- Loss and damage from climate change is a new challenge for existing institutional arrangements

# Responses and strategies

- Champions in government
- Building synergies and linkages between DRR, adaptation, development and loss and damage
- Clear understanding of institutional roles and capacities and how they may need to change to meet a new challenge
