- *We have an international network with Huairou Commission, who assist us in this regard. Besides, we have a network with C-MAN (Climate change Mitigation and Adaptation Network). Through these network we get some information on climate change issues.*

Even international CBA was held in Dhaka, Bangladesh organized by IIED and BCAS, but we did not get the message.*
- *Actually, without financial support it is very difficult to continue support for disaster affected people. At the moment we just try to help people by our own contribution.*

I was invited once through PRDA, but later on I do not know what they are doing and what is their policy. As at the moment we do not have any fund for climate change issue, we just stop our service for the disaster affected people. We do not have any web links in this regard. We have one short video, prepared by Taiwan media authority (Supreme Master Ching hai) including BRAC and PDAP.**

PDAP had worked with Khulna, Jessore, Munshigonj and Dhaka district. These areas are vulnerable to disaster.
