Methodologies on reviewing the adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation and support part 2

- ➤ SBI, SBSTA or AC and LEG in collaboration with others could organize **periodic in-session meetings of experts** aligned with the 5-yr cycle of the GST to review adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation and support
- The review could be guided by methodological questions and informed by relevant information, including contained in the adaptation communications
- > CMA could establish a **technical team of experts** (similar to ICA process) to undertake preliminary review, as input to the in-session meetings above
- AC and LEG could be mandated to develop and conduct training on a regular basis for the technical team of experts
- Reports of the review to feed into the GST to include: processes and systems, inputs and outputs, outcomes or demonstrable results, impacts or long - term societal, economic, or environmental consequences



Additional issues for consideration

- > Terms of reference (TOR) for the expert teams to be defined
- > Emphasis that the focus is on assessing collective progress
- > The review to be considered in a comprehensive and collective manner
