

Oct – Dec 2016

Two sets of user needs assessments in accordance with the concept paper conducted: 38 responses received (5 from Parties & 33 from organizations)

'Draft requirements' in a form of 'Look & Feel' of a possible online platform developed by the secretariat, under the guidance of the coordinator of the intersessional working group

Excom 5 March 2017

'Look & Feel' of the online platform endorsed. UNFCCC to serve as a gateway of the Clearing House

Intersessional group of champions to:

- Identify and engage potential partners, agree on their roles in the development and maintenance of the Clearing House;
- Develop a 'dummy/mockup/initial' version of the Clearing House

Apr – Sep 2017

Teleconference calls of the group of champions held to enable the technical implementation of the Clearing House and provide suggestions for potential partners to the clearing house.

- Initiated technical implementation of the **Clearing House jointly** with partners;
- Conducted initial research to build up the contents.

Excom 6 October 2017

Presentation of the working version of clearing house, jointly with partners for feedback.
