TASK FORCE ON DISPLACEMENT (TF)

Relationship between AA6 of the 2-year workplan, the 5-year rolling workplan and the task force?

- TF as a subsidiary body to the ExCom, reporting back to the ExCom;
- Primary focus is on the mandate given by 1/CP.21;
- Linkage to the 2-year workplan is a sequencing question. TF may build on the work of Action Area 6 or contribute to the implementation of it, depending on the timing of its operationalization.
- Open to option that TF may help to implement the 5-year rolling workplan.

Preferable for the task force to develop its own workplan and send to Excom for approval?

- TF should develop its own workplan, send it to ExCom for approval;
- ToR to include an indicative list of activities;

Aspects/ areas that a working group can achieve common understanding on at Excom 3?

- Eliminate repetitions, including many references to existing bodies/ reference to the particular partnerships/ organizations, delete last two bullets ("consider the integration...") simplify it.
- Scope of work:
 - Idea for a chapeau in order to avoid repetitions: "in the context of developing recommendations for integrated approaches to avert, minimize and address displacement related to the adverse impacts of climate change";
 - Identification of legal and institutional challenges, good practices, lessons learned, as appropriate, for managing migration under climate change in the near-, midand long-term in the context of developing recommendations on how to address these challenges;
 - TF to provide opportunities for parties to articulate their questions and needs, best practices, lessons learned;
 - List of target audience, including, inter alia, scientific and technical communities, Parties;
- Activities, deliverables and suggested timeframes:
 - Did not manage to go through it.
 - Indicative list of activities should include issue of slow onset events:

- Creation of the indicative list of partnerships/ initiatives to build on.
