



NAPA Implementation

- NAPA US\$ 350m estimated
- At least 80% of the total fund must reach to field/site
- Funding accessed within/outside the Convention Regime
- LDC Fund Two PIFs submitted one approved
- Bilateral DFID/EU community-based adaptation and USAID Hariyo Ban (Green Forests) Programme - climate adaptation component
- UNEP/UNDP/IUCN Ecosystem-Based Adaptation Project - Nepal, Peru and Uganda
- PPCR climate resilience and adaptation

Next Steps

- Finalisation of LAPA framework and manual framework now under consultation
- Further alignment into national development adaptation as national development agenda
- Project development for NAPA Implementation
- Implementation of Climate Change Policy, 2011
- Strengthening of institutions and coordination mechanisms
- Formulation of climate change strategy and framework for climate fund - started
