

•	Relatively few regional level adaptation initiatives, most in the Pacific
•	Mainly climate observation, assessment and capacity building
•	Also initiatives supporting <b>practical adaptation initiatives</b> , ex. in the Asia Pacific region ( <i>Pacific Vulnerability and Adaptation</i> <i>Initiative and the Climate Change Partnerships</i> )
	Needs: capacity building (especially in GIS and data analysis), regional leadership, political commitment



#### Local

- Local level government: mostly target-specific measures, some climate change plans. Mainly water resources management, coastal zone management, flood prevention and health.
  - Hindered by lack of awareness, lack of guidance, political buy-in.
- <u>CBA</u>: often specific adaptation projects or local action committees involved in preparing vulnerability assessment and response plans.
  - Concerns: limited scale and impact (it is time-consuming, NGO led, and donor dependent); traditional knowledge under-valued.

## Needs and concerns

- coordination -including developing a common understanding of the threats and opportunities and identifying roles and responsibilities
- · political buy-in; early engagement of stakeholders
- scaling to suitable level in spatial and temporal terms
- financial barriers relate both to insufficient budget and to the nature of the funds available, which are often deemed to be inappropriate for the kind of cross-sectoral, multi-level and flexible approach needed for adaptation


