Objective

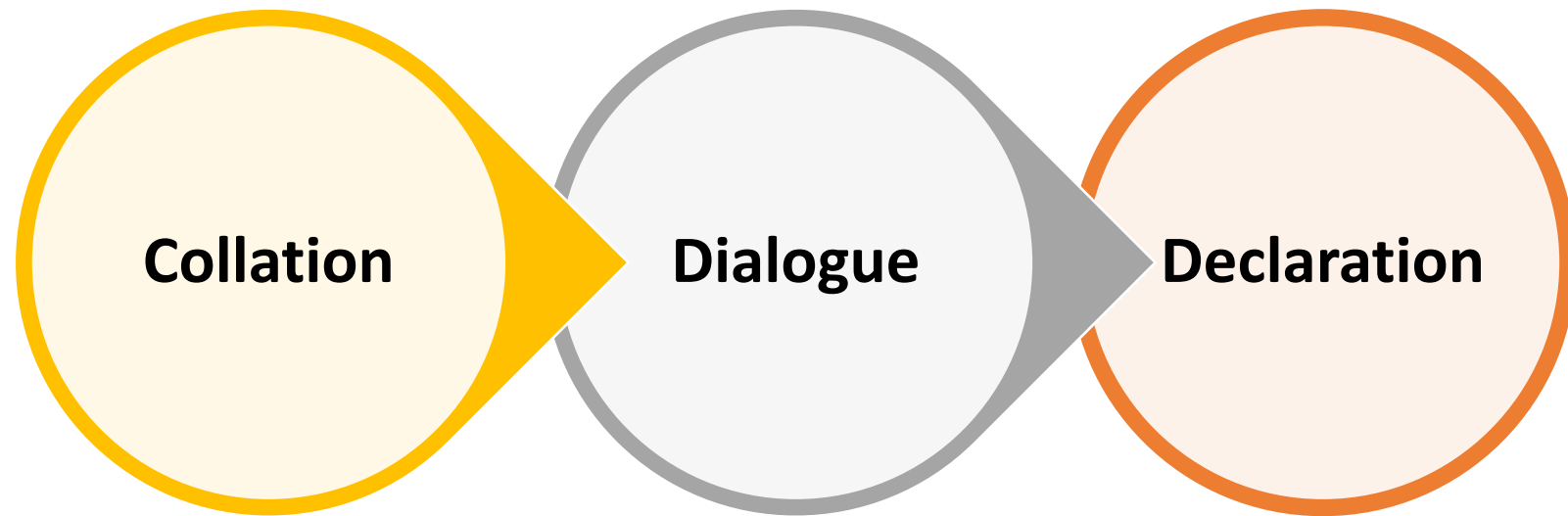
- Take stock of the implementation of Paris Agreement **to assess the collective progress** towards achieving the purpose of this Agreement and its long-term goals.
- It shall do so in a **comprehensive and facilitative manner**, considering mitigation, adaptation and the means of implementation and support, and in the light of equity and the best available science.

Features

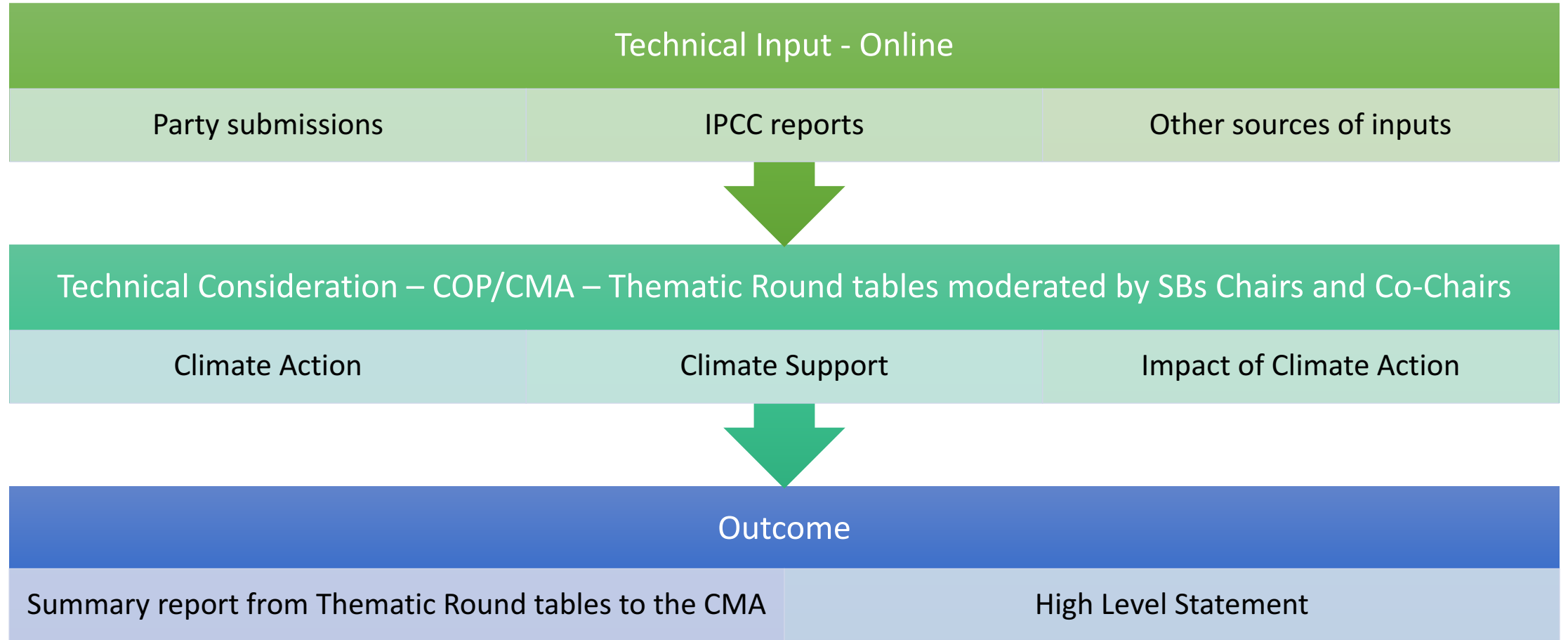
- Simple design (Cooperative discourse), with neither phases nor work streams
- Conducted by the CMA and a simple design ending with information delivered and communicated to Parties
- Efficient design, pragmatic, cost-effective approach with the outcome agreed by Parties
- Collected sources of inputs with a process that is facilitative, Party-driven and Party-specific;
- Timing (*duration*): short, in order to avoid undue burden on parties, and concise in order to ensure durability and resilience of the process.

GST – Model 3 - Operationalization

Input

- GST Portal for uploading sources of input including Party submissions, IPCC reports, reports from SBs
- A compilation of these inputs to be undertaken by Secretariat.

Modality

- Technical Consideration of compiled inputs to be carried out during COP/CMA session within three thematic round tables moderated by SBs Chairs and Co-Chairs:
 - Climate Action, Climate Support, Impact of Climate Action

Outcome

- A summary report from thematic round tables to CMA.
- High Level Statement

Outcome

- Inform Parties in a nationally determined manner
- Includes best practices, and positive communication
- Identifies gaps that exist between needs, action, and support; climate action-specific, and support for that action and the impact of that action
- Review the effectiveness of adaption action and support
- Review the overall progress made in achieving the global goal on adaptation
- Review of climate action within the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication and economic diversification with an assessment of Parties resilience to the impact of response measures
