

**Update on the consultations on the elections of the ADP Bureau by the Presidency with the Coordinators of regional groups, on Monday, 21 May 2012 at 16:30 hours**

Consultations continued this afternoon between the Presidency and the Chairs of the Regional groups.

Groups informed that they were still consulting on the new proposed approach discussed at the meeting earlier today.

The meeting noted that there is convergence on the principles and the rules for the arrangements for the ADP Bureau which would meet all the needs of Parties.

The Presidency encouraged groups to sit together to discuss how to move forward, even for only the first two years of the work of the ADP. The candidates and their respective countries should also be invited to participate in those discussions, and groups should draw on the assistance of the Chair of the G77 and China.
