Mitigation Section

Agreement Text

- NEW Para 2bis:
 - Each Party shall communicate its first nationally determined mitigation contribution upon joining this Agreement.
- Para 3: Add additional rules on the design of a Party's nationally determined mitigation contribution, along the lines of the text proposed by New Zealand.
- Para 6: Add language that ensures that Parties come back at a common/ harmonized time every five years to communicate or revisit/recommunicate their intended nationally determined mitigation contributions, along the lines of the text proposed by Japan.
- Para 8:
 - Parties acknowledge the importance of economic diversification and cooperation to <u>enhance the positive impacts and</u> reduce the adverse impacts of the implementation of response measures [, including through the institutional arrangements as defined in decision 1/CP.21].
- Para 10:
 - The CMA shall facilitate the enhancement of the clarity, transparency and understanding of the intended nationally determined mitigation contributions communicated by Parties, <u>including through a consultative period during</u> <u>which successive or [revisited/recommunicated] intended nationally</u> <u>determined mitigation contributions are communicated well before their</u> <u>finalization</u>.

Decision Text

- Para 23: Add a list of the minimum up front information to be provided with NDMCs, along the lines of the text provided by New Zealand.
- NEW Para 28bis:

- Requests the IPC to facilitate the enhancement of the clarity, transparency and understanding of the successive or [revisited/recommunicated] intended nationally determined mitigation contributions communicated by Parties well before their finalization by providing Parties the opportunity to consider them through:
 - <u>a facilitative dialogue that promotes clarity, transparency and understanding, and</u>
 - <u>an updated synthesis report on the aggregate effect of nationally</u> <u>determined mitigation contributions before their finalization.</u>
- NEW para 28ter:
 - Decides that each Party shall communicate a successive or [revisited/recommunicated] intended nationally determined contribution well before [the CMA in 2021]
- Para 30: Edit to reflect rules on tracking progress towards the implementation and achievement of nationally determined mitigation contributions, along the lines of that proposed by New Zealand and Norway.
- Para 33: Add option of "no provision on response measures"
