

**Dedicated Meeting on Ways and Means to Advance the
Technical Examination Process in 2015 – 10 February 2015**

India's intervention in TEM meeting on 10 February 2015:

"It is important to recognize that actions under Workstream II (WSII) must be undertaken by the developed countries to enhance implementation of their commitments to ensure the highest possible mitigation efforts under the Convention. In this regard WSII must also focus on the provision of means of implementation including technology transfer, finance and capacity building support to be provided by developed country parties to the developing country parties, recognizing that such implementation will enhance ambition in the pre-2020 period.

The UNFCCC is suggested to undertake the following for strengthening the TEM process in a balanced manner with focus on mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation in forthcoming sessions and in- sessions:-

a. There is a need to move forward from the present stage of WSII that primarily provides generic information on high potential areas. Future work shall be focused translating potential into workable options, both in developed and developing countries, that take into consideration country specific requirements .This may require quantification of opportunities and establishing linkages with technology providers and financing institutions , mapping capacity building requirements and facilitating the same. It is apprehended that in absence of these WSII may remain largely an academic exercise; and

b. TEM to identify opportunities with high adaptation co- benefits linked to regional and national circumstances in the areas of integrated coastal zone management, livelihood security and disaster management etc. TEMs should also focus on finance and technology transfers, and implementation of previous decisions in Warsaw and Lima."
