

## **Proposals by co-facilitators for Article 3.16 on cooperative approaches and related decision paragraphs**

### **OPTION I<sup>1</sup>**

#### **A. DRAFT AGREEMENT**

**[Article 3 ter]** [\(MECHANISM TO SUPPORT SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT\)](#)

*{To replace Article 3.16 in compilation}*

16. Parties acknowledge the importance of cooperative approaches for implementing and enhancing the ambition of climate action at the international level.
- 16bis. Where cooperative approaches involve the use of internationally transferred mitigation outcomes towards NDMCs, Parties participating shall [safeguard] [promote] sustainable development and environmental integrity and shall apply robust accounting to ensure, inter alia, that double counting is avoided, taking into account relevant guidance adopted for this purpose by the CMA.
- 16ter. A share of proceeds for adaptation shall apply.

#### **B. DRAFT DECISION**

- X. Requests the IPC to develop and recommend the guidance referred to under Article [3.16] for adoption by the CMA at its first session.

### **OPTION II**

Cooperative approaches of Parties, based on Article 4.7 of the Convention, must ensure the enhancement of mitigation outcomes together with adaptation co-benefits to be verified internationally but non-transferrable.
