16. Parties acknowledge the importance of [cooperation in][cooperative approaches for] implementing and enhancing the ambition of climate action [at the international level].

16alt. Parties may also cooperate in the implementation of [NMDC*]/[INDC][NDC]

[16bis. Where cooperative approaches involve the use of internationally transferred mitigation outcomes towards [NMDC*]/[INDC][NDC], Parties participating shall [safeguard] [promote] sustainable development and environmental integrity and shall apply robust accounting to ensure, inter alia, that double counting is avoided, taking into account relevant guidance adopted for this purpose by the CMA [taking into account guidance adopted at the national level].]

[16ter. A share of proceeds for adaptation shall apply.]
