### Vision

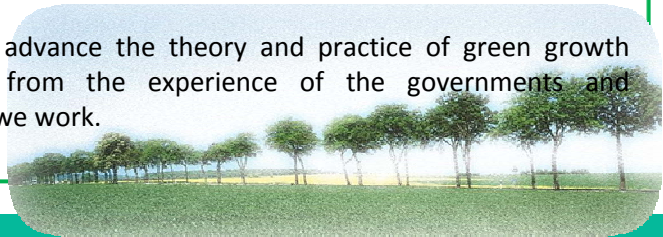

2. Facilitating public-private cooperation to strengthen the enabling environment for resource-efficient investment, innovation and diffusion of best practice in the private sector.

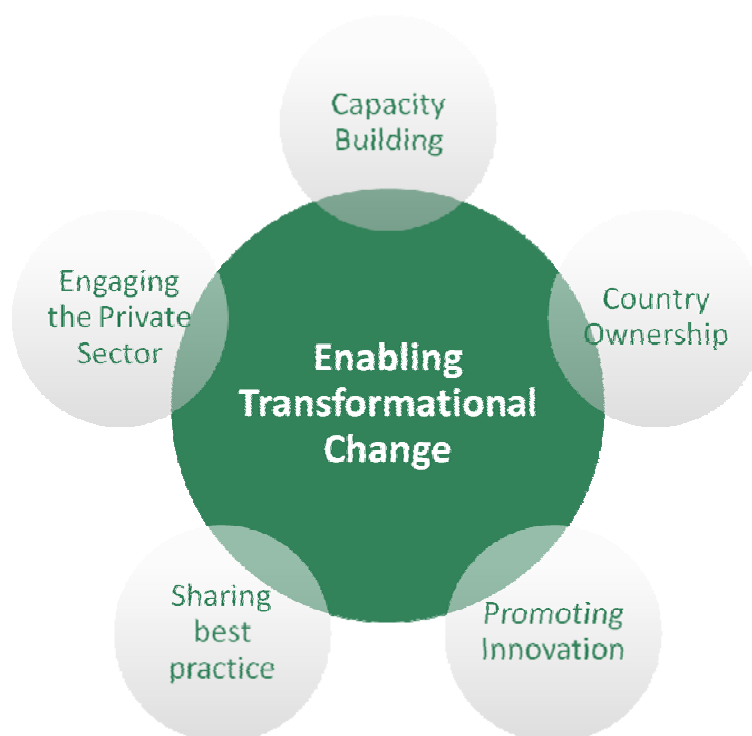
3. Pursue research to advance the theory and practice of green growth drawing particularly from the experience of the governments and industries with which we work.

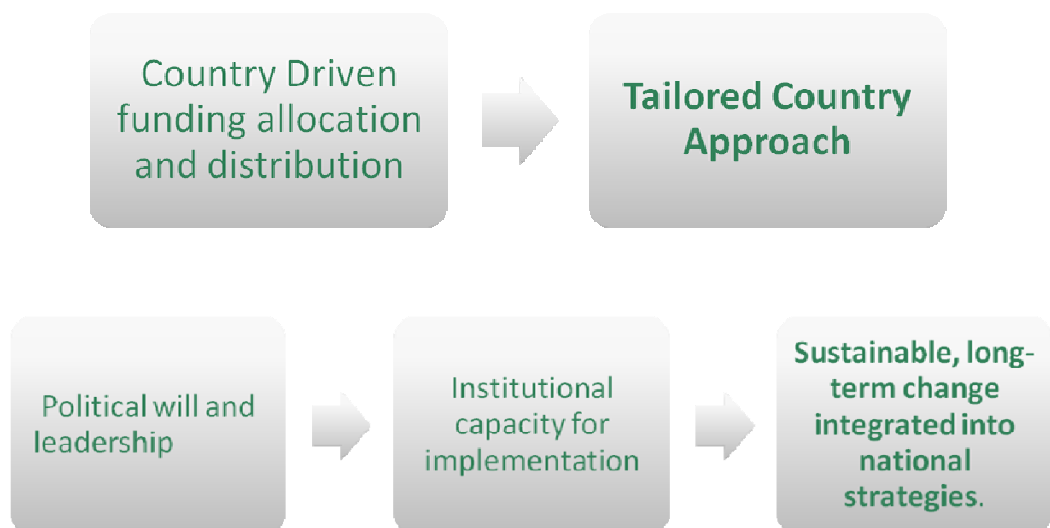
