Evidence of CC in Rwanda

- The average value was 19.8°C in 1971 and 20.7°C in 2007, making an increase of 0.9°C in 27 years
- Decrease in number of days of rainfall :148 to 124 (1971 – 2009)

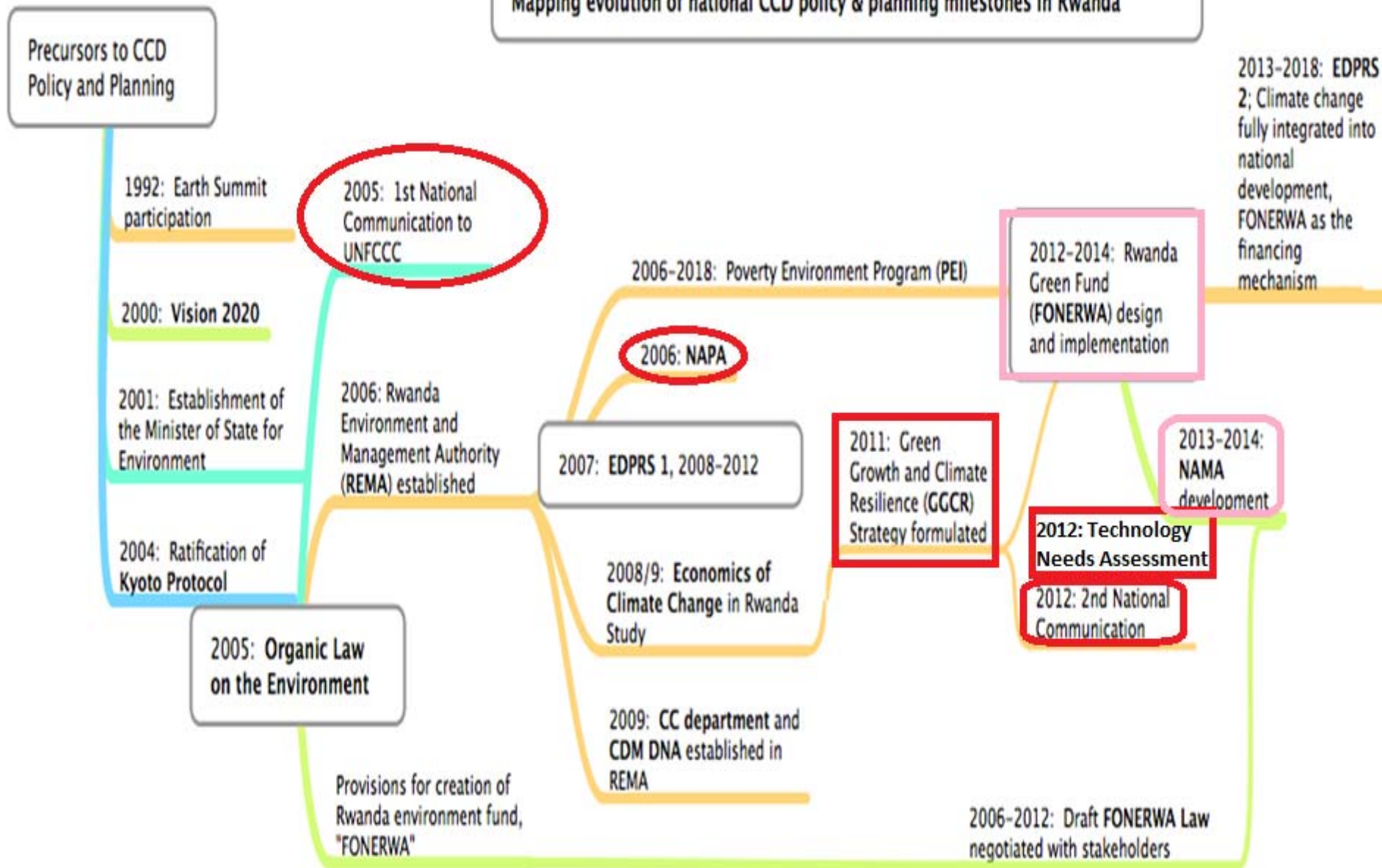


Rwanda Vulnerability to Climate Change




Mapping evolution of National CCD

Challenges	Solutions
<p>Limited number of national experts in CC related issues and lack of adequate data for weather prediction</p>	<p>Enhanced Early Warning System by installing additional 22 Automatic weather stations and developing capacity of cross sectoral team of experts . MSc programs</p>
<p>Insufficient ownership from user sectors (Agriculture, Energy,...)</p>	<p>Mainstreaming of Climate change in the National Planning and facilitators at Ministry and Districts levels</p>
<p>Limited Financial capacity</p>	<p>Establishing FONERWA with a window on R& Capacity Development, Accreditation of MINIRENA as NIE for Adaptation Fund</p>
<p>Limited awareness</p>	<p>Public awareness raising program (TV, Radio) and training targeting specific Groups like Youth, Women and Private sector. Establishment of Rwanda climate Portal.</p>
<p>Insufficient coordination</p>	<p>Establishment of Climate change Unit and Green Economy National Committees</p>
